ZETA OMICRON VOCATIONAL/TECHNICAL SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

1. *Scholarship will be in the amount of \$300.00.*
2. *Any Cedaredge High School Graduating senior with a minimum of a 2.0 grade point average may apply*
3. *Applicant must have a career goal in mind and a plan for reaching that goal.*
4. *Applicant should have demonstrated interest in the chosen career through classes taken in school, activities participated in through or outside of school, and/or related job or volunteer experiences.*
5. *Applicant is to include two character references from two unrelated adults. Only one of the references may be from a teacher. Attach the two character references to the scholarship application.*
6. *Scholarship recipient must enroll in a Trade or Vocational School or in a trade or vocational program at a Junior or Community College by the fall following High School Graduation. Should the recipient fail to do so, the scholarship will be offered to alternates in order of their ranking.*
7. *Scholarship funds will be sent to the student no later than August after verification of enrollment and attendance is received.*
